

Notice To Mariner No. 79/2004

**SUBJECT : INTERNATIONAL SHIP & PORT FACILITY SECURITY CODE
(ISPS)**

According to ISPS Code, please advise all your principals on the following,

1. 1 July, 2004 is the mandatory date to implement the code for all Ports and Ships. All vessels calling port of Fujairah or Fujairah Offshore Anchorage Area should comply with all requirements of ISPS Code.
2. The International Ship Security Certificate (SSC) and the certificates as per our Notice to Mariner No. 74 dated 07/01/2003 must valid and available onboard the vessels calling at Port of Fujairah or at Fujairah Offshore Anchorage Area.
3. ISPS Code makes the following items mandatory to ships,
 - a) Ship Security Alarm.
 - b) IMO Number painted on the ship.
 - c) Continuous Synopsis Record.
 - d) Company Security Officer.
 - e) Ship Security Officer.
 - f) Ship Security Assessment.
 - g) Ship Security Plan.
 - h) International Ship Security Certificate.
4. Port of Fujairah can allow vessels to call the port's area to have the verification, and a copy of Interim International Security Certificate must be submitted to Marine Department on completion, otherwise the vessel will be instructed to leave from the area.

Vessel must report to control Tower on the time of receiving surveyor, start and completion of verification, issuance of the Interim certificate and its status.
