## Notice to Mariners No. 373

**SUBJECT : GLOBAL NAVIGATION SATELLITE SYSTEM (GNSS)  
INTERFERENCE AND REQUIREMENTS FOR FULLY  
OPERATIONAL NAVIGATIONAL EQUIPMENT**

Please be advised that GNSS electronic interference is currently affecting the navigation systems in the region. In view of these conditions, all vessels calling Port of Fujairah and Dibba Port are required to ensure that all critical navigational equipment, including but not limited to radars, speed log, gyro compass, magnetic compass, steering systems, and associated bridge equipment, are fully operational and tested prior to arrival.


Particular emphasis is placed on the proper functioning of the non-GNSS dependent speed log namely doppler or electromagnetic speed logs, which are considered essential for safe pilotage and berthing operations under the prevailing navigational conditions. Vessels not fitted with a fully operational speed log, or with defective/unreliable speed log indications, will not be permitted to berth or conduct port movements until the deficiency has been rectified to the satisfaction of the Port Authority.

Masters are reminded of their obligation to accurately declare any navigational equipment defects prior to arrival.

Should a Pilot identify any undeclared malfunction or deficiency in critical navigational equipment during the vessel call or maneuvering operations, the vessel movement will be suspended immediately until corrective actions are completed. Any delays, additional pilotage, tug assistance, or other marine service charges arising therefrom shall be for the vessel's account.

Please advise all your principals accordingly.
